TASTING NOTES

SHINY AND RUBY RED WITH PURPLE HUES, THE FIRST NOSE REVEALS FRESH CHERRIES WITH A HINT OF DUSTY ROSE PETALS AND EXOTIC SPICE: CINNAMON, MACE AND NUTMEG. IT QUICKLY OPENS UP TO REVEAL FRESH STRAWBERRY PIE AND POMEGRANATE NOSE, LACED WITH RED CURRANTS, BERGAMOT & FLORAL NOTES. SMOOTH, LIGHT AND VELVETY ON THE PALATE, WITH FRESH BERRY NOTES COATING AND RESTRAINED; AND SAVORY SPICE NOTES LINGERING ON THE LONG FINISH. A WINE OF A SILKY OPEN TEXTURE AND GIVING.
