TASTING NOTES

SHINY AND DEEP GARNET IN COLOR WITH VIOLET HUES, THE INITIAL AROMAS REVEAL AN INTERESTING MIX OF DARK CHERRIES AND LAVENDER WITH HINTS OF EXOTIC SPICE: CARDAMOM AND NUTMEG. IT

OPENS NICELY TO REVEAL MIXED BERRY NOTES, AND SPICED CHERRIES LACED WITH INTRIGUING ROSEMARY. THE PALATE CARRIES MIXED BERRY FLAVORS WRAPPED WITH HINTS OF COCOA ON A SPICY FRAME. A VERY SMOOTH ENTRY WITH A WONDERFULLY LUSH TEXTURE CARRIES THE MOUTHFEEL WITH VELVETY TANNINS TO THE LONG, LINGERING FINISH. THIS HIGHLY COMPLEX WINE, WITH ITS SILKY AND OPEN MOUTHFEEL IS A CROWD PLEASER.
