2015 Tualatin Estate Pinot Noir

Score 93 • \$65

(raised in French oak barrels, 30% of them new) Light bright red. Sexy, energetic aromas of ripe red fruits, candied flowers and allspice, joined by slowly emerging hints of blood orange and licorice. Juicy and energetic on the palate, offering appealingly sweet raspberry, cherry and rose pastille flavors and a touch of bitter chocolate. In a fresh, exuberant style. The very long, gently tannic, lively finish echoes the blood orange note. -*Josh Reynolds, Vinous, January 2018*

2015 Lazy River Vineyard Pinot Noir (Yamhill-Carlton AVA)

Score 93 • \$55

Deep bright-hued red. Expansive, mineral-tinged cherry and raspberry liqueur scents, along with hints of candied flowers and Asian spices that build in the background. Silky and broad on entry and then more taut in the midpalate, offering appealingly sweet red fruit, spicecake and rose pastille flavors that show excellent clarity and lift. Smooth tannins frame the finish, which hangs on with strong, floral-driven tenacity. -*JR*

2015 Nysa Vineyard Pinot Noir

Score 94 • \$65

Vivid red. Highly perfumed aromas of fresh raspberry, Asian spices, potpourri and smoky minerals take on an exotic incense nuance with aeration. Silky, seamless and sweet on the palate; lively acidity and floral notes provide energy and lift to the concentrated red fruit liqueur, spicecake and floral pastille flavors. Blends power and delicacy with a sure hand and finishes extremely long, featuring zesty minerality and fine-grained tannins that sneak in late. -*JR*

2015 Elton Vineyard Pinot Noir

Score 94 • \$75

Dark red. Ripe red berries, pungent flowers and herbs, Indian spices and a hint of vanilla on the highly perfumed nose. Silky, seamless and appealingly sweet; a touch of peppery spice adds bite to the concentrated raspberry and cherry liqueur flavors. Takes a turn to darker fruit with air and finishes impressively long, displaying excellent clarity and velvety tannins that add shape. -*JR*

2015 Temperance Hill Vineyard Pinot Noir

Score 95 • \$75

Brilliant red. A highly perfumed bouquet of red fruit liqueur, cherry pie, candied flowers and Asian spices carries a smoky mineral overtone. Impressively concentrated yet lithe on the palate, offering sweet, mineral-laced raspberry, cherry cola, rose pastille and spicecake flavors that spread out steadily with air. Delivers a suave blend of power and finesse and finishes with harmonious tannins, outstanding clarity and intense, floral-driven persistence. -*JR*



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2015 Elton Vineyard Chardonnay

Score 94 • \$60

Limpid yellow-gold. Fresh honeydew, Meyer lemon, pear nectar and toasted brioche on the deeply perfumed, mineral-accented nose. Juicy and expansive on the palate, offering densely packed yet lively orchard and citrus fruit and sweet butter flavors and a nervy suggestion of gingery spices. Shows impressive energy and mineral cut on the clinging finish, which features a suave floral quality and a touch of oyster shell. The blend of power and finesse here is quite something. -JR

2015 Lazy River Vineyard Chardonnay

Score 93 • \$45

Pale yellow. Mineral-tinged nectarine, orange, honey and white flowers on the intensely perfumed nose. Smooth, fleshy and dry in the mouth, offering juicy orchard and pit fruit flavors complemented by suggestions of fennel, sweet butter and candied lemon peel. Shows excellent depth as well as energy and finishes minerally, dry and very long, featuring citrus and pit fruit notes. -JR
