



2016 Lazy River Vineyard Pinot Noir (Yamhill-Carlton)

Score 94 & Editors' Choice • \$55

Lovely aromatics introduce bright, fresh and forward raspberry and tart cherry fruit. It's supple and well proportioned, with lingering threads of coffee, iron and graphite adding texture and detail. This should continue to drink quite well over the next six to eight years. -Paul Gregutt, *Wine Enthusiast*

2016 Nysa Vineyard Pinot Noir (Dundee Hills)

Score 93 • \$65

Tightly packed with tart berry fruit, highlighted with sharp tangy acidity, there's some bite to this young wine which should profit from further bottle age. Black cherry and blood orange, along with hints of pepper and mushroom, display the range and depth of flavor here. Drink from 2022 on. -PG

2016 Temperance Hill Vineyard Pinot Noir (Eola-Amity Hills)

Score 93 • \$75

All of Lavinea's wines are deftly detailed, but none more than this. Citrus, rosemary, wet rock and well-ripened tannins add complexity to the core of blueberry and brandied cherry fruit. Beautifully balanced and long, it's coming together nicely and should continue to improve over the next half decade or more. -PG

2016 Elton Vineyard Pinot Noir (Eola-Amity Hills)

Score 92 • \$75

A smooth, supple, yet muscular wine, this brings blackberry and black-cherry fruit, a vein of cola and a dusting of chocolate powder. It's already drinking quite nicely, with well-integrated fruit and barrel flavors, while a nice lemony acidity underscores the finish. -PG

2016 Tualatin Estate Pinot Noir (Willamette Valley)

Score 91 • \$65

This 44-year-old vineyard was picked early, keeping finished alcohol well below last year's bottling. Clean Bing cherry fruit with a lovely seam of mocha washing over and through the palate makes this especially inviting for near-term drinking. -PG

2016 Lazy River Vineyard Chardonnay (Yamhill-Carlton)

Score 94 & Cellar Selection • \$45

This wine was barrel fermented in 20% new French oak. It's racy, inviting and aromatic, with sharp flavors of lemon, gooseberry, lime and cantaloupe. Tart and stylish, it's built for aging, though immediately enjoyable. Drink now–2028.

2016 Elton Vineyard Chardonnay (Eola-Amity Hills)

Score 92 • \$60

Fresh and deep, this offers ripe fruit flavors of apple, Asian pear and white melon. It was fermented in barrel with native yeast and 20% new oak. The structure, as with all Lavinea wines, is perfectly balanced for optimal tension and texture. -PG
