2015 NYSA VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

Nestled at a very high elevation between Domaine Drouhin Oregon and Archery Summit, the Nysa Vineyard is perched high on an Eastern slope with gorgeous valley views. This is our latest ripening vineyard which sets naturally low yields on intense volcanic Jory soils. Planted in 2003, this is our youngest of the portfolio, yet one of the most complex, capturing the typical cherry notes that made the Dundee Hills famous, completed by earthy characters with wonderful textures and a long vibrant finish.

TASTING NOTES

Clear and shiny, deep ruby red in color with a softer edge, the initial aromas dance between red cherries, strawberry and fragrant floral scents so distinctive of the Dundee Hills. It quickly reveals a bouquet of wildflowers and candied cherry aromas framed by earthy mineral notes. The palate is very bright, with a smooth and mouth filling texture, a deep core of red and black cherries, and a refined and chalky texture that lingers on the mineral and earthy finish. A highly aromatic wine with a wonderful structure to age.
