This 44-year-old vineyard was picked early, keeping finished alcohol well below last year's bottling. Clean Bing cherry fruit with a lovely seam of mocha washing over and through the palate makes this especially inviting for near-term drinking. *-PG*

Graceful and elegantly complex, with rose petal and raspberry aromas accented by river stone, blueberry and green tea flavors that glide toward polished tannins. Drink now through 2024. 239 cases made. *-TF*

Bright red. A sexy, highly perfumed bouquet evokes ripe red berries, incense and allspice, and a smoky mineral accent adds urgency. Juicy, appealingly sweet and lively for the vintage, offering concentrated raspberry, cherry liqueur and spiced flavors that show impressive lift and tension on the back half. Delivers a solid punch of flavor and comes off impressively graceful for its depth, showing no rough edges on the extremely long, mineral-driven finish. (30% new French oak) *-Josh Reynolds*
