### 2017 ELTON VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

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#### WINE ENTHUSIAST

Robust and tangy flavors propel a juicy mix of citrus and berry, notably orange and strawberry. The use of native yeast and the light touch with 22% new oak barrels are part of the winery's signature style, which focuses on single-vineyard examples from older plantings among the Willamette Valley's most interesting AVAs. Lightly savory and finishing with a touch of cocoa, this fragrant and rather restrained wine should be enjoyed over the next half decade. —*Paul Gregutt*

Shows impressive depth as well as energy on the palate, offering appealingly sweet, mineral-laced cherry and red berry flavors and a touch of spicecake. Finishes sappy, focused and impressively long, with repeating blood orange and floral nuances and gently chewy tannins. —*Josh Reynolds*
