There's a dense blueberry core that concentrates the flavors in this wine, which, along with the Temperance Hill, is the ripest of all Lavinea's 2017s. It breathes open into a lovely burst of sweet cinnamon and punchy allspice, adding texture and detail through a long finish. *—Paul Gregutt*

Bright-hued ruby color. Fragrant, spice-tinged aromas of raspberry, cherry, boysenberry and candied rose take on a smoky nuance with air. Fleshy and concentrated but energetic as well, the Lazy River Vineyard offers sappy red/blue fruit flavors that spread out slowly and turn sweeter through the mid-palate. It finishes on a resonating cherry note, with solid thrust, well-judged tannins and strong, floral-driven persistence. *—Josh Reynolds*
