Clear and resonant Bing cherry fruit is highlighted with rather delicate aromas of lavender and moist earth. The use of native yeast and a pleasingly light application of new French oak (22%) keep all the details in view, and the wine persists with a firm spine of steely minerality through a lingering, yet restrained, finish. *—Paul Gregutt*

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Deep, shimmering scarlet. A complex, highly perfumed bouquet displays spice-tinged raspberry liqueur, cherry and floral pastille scents, plus a deeper cola accent and a hint of smoky minerality. Silky and seamless on the palate, offering expansive red and blue fruit, floral pastille and spicecake flavors supported by a core of juicy acidity. Shows impressive delineation and finishes very long and minerally, with smooth tannins and an echo of candied flowers and cherry. *—Josh Raynolds*
