Limpid magenta. A highly complex bouquet evokes red berry and cherry preserves, along with building Asian spice, rose oil and smoky mineral nuances. Shows fine delineation on the palate, offering concentrated, spice-laced red fruit liqueur, cola and floral pastille flavors that turn livelier with air. Finishes impressively long and pure, with polished tannins providing shape and gentle grip to lingering raspberry and spicecake notes. —*Josh Reynolds*
