Pale straw-yellow. A complex, assertively perfumed bouquet evokes ripe citrus and orchard fruits, candied fig and sweet butter, along with hints of iodine and smoky minerals. Palate-staining citrus and orchard fruit flavors show impressive depth and complicating suggestions of honeysuckle, brioche and chalky minerals. Densely packed and energetic in style, finishing with superb clarity and strong, mineral and floral persistence. These vines were planted in 1993. 20% new oak. *-Josh Reynolds*
