Light, bright yellow. Youthful, tightly focused scents of fresh orange, pear, iodine and smoky minerals are complicated by fennel, jasmine and iodine. Sappy, penetrating and pure on the palate, offering intense citrus and orchard fruit, melon and honeysuckle flavors enlivened by a jolt of smoky minerality. Impressively concentrated yet graceful in character. Finishes very long and precise, with firm thrust and reverberating floral and mineral qualities. 20% new oak. –Josh Reynolds
