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### 2019 Temperance Hill Vineyard Pinot Noir

The 2019 Pinot Noir Temperance Hill Vineyard moves into a darker profile, with notes of kirsch, incense, and anise. The palate is dry and has depth, with red and black fruit, espresso, and turned soil. It has a more compact structure, which will take time to unfold.

### 2019 Tualatin Estate Pinot Noir

The 2019 Pinot Noir Tualatin Estate is fresh with pure strawberry, slaty earth, and fresh roses, and the palate is medium-bodied, with silky, fine tannins, red raspberry, and rocky earth. I love this for its freshness, elegance, and transparent nature.

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### 2019 Elton Vineyard Pinot Noir

The nose of the 2019 Pinot Noir Elton Vineyard is gorgeous with pure, ripe red cherry, raspberry, fresh pine, and fresh roses. It has a bit more structure and a hint of warming baking spices on the palate, with pomegranate and orange peel.

### 2019 Elton Vineyard Chardonnay

The 2019 Chardonnay Elton Vineyard is fresh with wet stone, lime zest, and Bosc pear. The palate is refreshing and energetic, building with intensity and showing its pedigree through the finish, with notes of stony earth, lime candy, and vibrant green apple.

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
